Green plans run for mayor

Resident and community leader Greg Green will run for mayor next year. Green was a Ward 1 alderman candidate in 2009 and will challenge Mayor William Truly. Business merchants on the square hosted a meet and greet for Green Aug. 16 at Krazy Taste Buds that drew more than 60 people.
