Butler, Snow, O'Mara, Stevens & Cannada PLLC again took top honors in the 99-employees-or-less category, edging out legal rival Adams and Reese LLP and other finalists CBIZ MHM Thompson Dunavant, W.G. Yates & Sons Construction Co. and Metropolitan Bank.

In the 100-499 employees category, steel building manufacturer Varco Pruden Buildings Inc. was recognized as the healthiest employer. It beat out Ring Container Technologies, last year's winner in the category, as well as Church Health Center, Morrison Management Specialists and Baker, Donelson, Bearman, Caldwell & Berkowitz PC.

St. Jude Children's Research Hospital retained its crown in the 500-plus category, edging out competitors including SRVS, Baptist Memorial Hospital-Memphis, University of Memphis and University of Tennessee Health Science Center.
