United Way of South Mississippi kicks off 2013 campaign

SOUTH MISSISSIPPI (WLOX) - The footballs were being tossed Tuesday morning at the IP Casino Resort and Spa in Biloxi during the annual United Way of South Mississippi Campaign kickoff.

Each year the nonprofit holds a football themed kickoff where participating local companies wear their company's jersey or a football jersey of their favorite football team.

Several of the nearly 200 local companies that take part in the fundraising efforts attended the ceremony that featured speakers and drawings for prizes including a Drew Brees signed football.

Two of the New Orleans Saintsations Jerami of Long Beach and Brandy of Ocean Springs attended the event.

This year's company pacesetters, which are the companies who started their employee fundraisers early, are Arcata Associates Inc., Butler Snow O'mara, Stevens and Cannada, PPLC, Center Point Energy, the Grand Biloxi Casino, Hancock Bank, Mississippi Power, Regions Bank, Target, Walmart and United

Collectively the pacesetters have already raised \$500,000 towards United Way's goal of \$1.5 million.

This year the United Way will focus on early childhood education specifically for children 0 to 8 years of age. According to the United Way, improving education ultimately improves quality of live for communities.

In addition to education the United Way also supports income and health programs or initiatives and agencies, United Way Director of Marketing and Communications Colleen McAdams said.





