GULFPORT KIWANIS CLUB HONORS WALTER ZELLER FELLOWS

The Gulfport Kiwanis Club recognized club members associated with Butler Snow Law Firm as they were named as Walter Zeller Fellows by Kiwanis International. Walter Zeller Fellows are named and recognized for their dedication to The Eliminate Project, Kiwanis International's worldwide project, which is a partnership with UNICEF to eliminate maternal and neonatal tetanus (MNT) from third world countries. Kiwanis International and UNICEF have pledged to raise \$110 million to eliminate MNT. This effort will require more than 100 million mothers and their future babies being vaccinated, and the purchase and distribution of vaccines, syringes, safe storage, transportation, and the training of thousands of medical personnel. Previously, Kiwanis International partnered with UNICEF in the 1990s to raise \$100 million for 103 third world countries to
